We are thrilled to announce an exciting opportunity for local artists to be involved in a brand new project at Shoreditch Town Hall.

On Saturday 29 October, the Town Hall will throw open its doors for a day of workshops, performances and events for all the family! A packed programme of theatre, music, dance and art activities will take place across the building.

As part of the programme, we're looking for Hackney-based artists to lead some of the workshop activity, doing what you do best. We're looking for artists who can offer a 60-minute workshop for up to 30 young participants and their accompanying adults. There are **NO limitations** on art form - we will consider **anything and everything** – however please note that it is likely these workshops will take place in one of our basement spaces meaning that the floor will be concrete and therefore not suitable for certain types of activity. If possible, we would love for your session to engage specifically with the local Hackney community, and are interested to hear how this might work in your initial expression of interest.
